**ORDINANCE 2262**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH, WASHINGTON  
AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE SNOHOMISH MUNICIPAL CODE  
(SMC) SECTION 11.10.030 “PERMIT ISSUANCE AUTHORITY”  
RELATING TO PARKING PERMITS AND PASS FEES AND REFUNDS;  
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it necessary to protect the public health and safety and promote the general welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City adopted Ordinance 2257 on September 3, 2013 amending SMC 11.10.030 establishing that no fee was required for a residential on-street parking permit or pass; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that during 2013 the City incurred little or no expense in the processing or enforcement of permit parking requirements under SMC Chapter 11.10; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds it necessary and appropriate to refund fees for parking permits issued under SMC 11.10.030;

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH,  
WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** SMC section 11.10.030 entitled “Permit Issuance Authority” is amended to read as follows:

**11.10.030 Permit Issuance Authority.** The Snohomish Chief of Police shall be authorized to issue permits for residential on-street parking and visitor passes, and to administer the application for and use of said permits and passes. No fee shall be required for a residential on-street parking permit or pass. The Chief of Police shall issue to each person applying for a permit an information sheet containing the terms, conditions, and rules under which the permit shall be issued. Permits for up to two vehicles per address or one permit for each licensed driver residing at the address may be issued, subject to the provisions of SMC 11.10.070. In addition, permit parking fees paid and received by the City during calendar year 2013 shall be refunded by the City to the permittee within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this ordinance.

**Section 2.** **Severability.** If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such a decision or preemption shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to any other persons or circumstances.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective five days after adoption and publication by summary.
