TREASURER'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 27th day of November 1922

between N. J. Craigue as treasurer of Snohomish County, State of Washington, the party of the first part, and City of Snohomish (For Playground Purposes Only) party of the second part.

WITNESSETH That whereas, at a public sale of real estate held on the 4th day of November A. D. 1922, pursuant to an order of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Snohomish, State of Washington, duly made and entered, and after having first given due notice of the time, and place and terms of said sale, and whereas, in pursuance of said order of the said Board of County Commissioners, and of the laws of the State of Washington, and for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 (10.00) DOLLARS,

lawful money of the United States of America, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have this day sold to City of Snohomish (For Playground Purposes Only) the following described real estate, and which said real estate is the property of Snohomish County, and which is particularly described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at center of Section Eighteen (18), Township Twenty eight (28), North of Range Six (6) East; - thence South 126 feet to Hill Street; thence East on North boundary of said Hill Street to West line of Pine Street; thence North to Southeast corner of Block One (1), Mrs Logan's Addition to Snohomish; thence West to 1/4 Section line; thence South to point of beginning; less Lincoln Street, 76/100 of an acre in Section Eighteen (18) Township Twenty eight (28) North of Range Six (6) East, Snohomish County, State of Washington, the said City of Snohomish (For Playground Purposes Only) being the highest and best bidder at said sale, and the said sum being the highest and best sum bid at said sale:
