

# A NEW DELIVERY METHOD FOR YOUR WATER QUALITY REPORT

The City of Snohomish will be providing the annual Water Quality Report in a digital format. This year, we will have the Water Quality Report available online for our residents to review and print if desired.

Previously, the City of Snohomish has mailed individual reports to every consumer on our water system. This method has become more expensive every year. This year a postcard will be mailed to all consumers when the Water Quality Report is available with a direct link to it on our website.

In 2011, Executive Review Order 13563 requested Federal Agencies to look for ways to reduce their burden, streamline language or processes, enhance efficiencies or when needed, expand for better clarity and inclusion. As part of this, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) looked for opportunities to improve communications between consumers and their water providers. To this end, EPA has issued a new interpretation of the existing Rule to allow for electronic delivery.
