Quorum lost when Mr. Mills exited the Zoom meeting approximately 5:25 p.m. The Commission was advised that no action could be taken due to lack of quorum. Mr. Mills later returned approximately 5:45 p.m., re-establishing the quorum.

Ms. Brovan inquired on how to begin with Neighborhood Watch. Councilmember Ray expressed involving the entire City to share awareness, and perhaps practicing presentations with Deputy Niebusch. Members could also share information with their own neighborhoods. The topic could be added as an item to an upcoming Commission meeting.

The Commission discussed future meeting topics, such as: items from the work plan, using City events to share Commission efforts, planning agendas ahead of time, and developing a working document accessible to members.

Ms. Strom questioned the Commission's contribution to the Quarterly Magazine. Commission members considered Neighborhood Watch, how to host town halls, and when will return to normal happen.
