Below is a proposed work plan for the Public Safety Commission. This will be a topic of discussion at tonight's meeting.

Public Safety Commission Work Plan

1. General Level of Public Safety within the City (e.g. public forums, unsolicited input, police/crime trends, Fire/EMS response data, etc.)
2. Create a how-to guide that helps City residents form a Neighborhood Watch.
3. Become a clearinghouse for public safety resources including disaster preparedness (including CERT), neighborhood safety, health, homelessness, domestic violence, and mental health. These resource links could be City, county, and state-wide.
4. Create a calendar of outreach events including Town Halls, Snohomish Police Open House, National Night Out, and other appropriate public safety themed events.
5. Reference of our charter domains:
 - a. Public Safety Education and Resource Access (map your neighborhood, community crime map, neighborhood watch, web resources)
 - b. Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Response (CERT training)
