

Second and Lincoln Traffic Signal Design Project Update and Public Notification

The City is pleased to announce that the Second Street and Lincoln Avenue Traffic Signal Project received grant funding this year and will be constructed. Construction is made possible through a federal grant which will fund 87.5% of the work. The grant will be administered through the Puget Sound Regional Council and was received in large part due to the recently completed Centennial Trail. The new traffic signal will improve the Trail's Second Street crossing. Construction is expected to start this summer.

Currently the project is close to gaining environmental approval which is the last step before being able to prepare for bidding the project for construction. Part of the grant process requires public notification of how the project will impact public lands (the trail). The event first took place in 2007, when 2.2 million residents of Sydney, Australia, participated by turning off all non-essential lights.
