## Construction Starts on Boat Launch Project

Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) has begun construction on the City's new boat launch! It is located along the Snohomish River near the southwest corner of First Street and Lincoln Avenue. The project was awarded to *Accord Contractors* out of Bellevue for approximately \$389,000. WDFW was awarded a grant from the *Jobs Now* program for the design, permitting and construction of the boat launch. After construction, the City will own the facility and be responsible for its operation and maintenance.

The facility will include a concrete boat ramp, asphalt-paved parking lot with eight trailer spaces and 11 standard spaces, concrete walkway, drainage swale, and plantings. Parking can be expanded as needed, seasonally or during special events into surrounding field areas. The City is currently evaluating a parking fee, including the amount for vehicles with boat trailers and available methods for payment.

According to permit requirements in-water construction, which includes the boat ramp, must be completed by the end of September and balance of the project will be completed by the end of 2015 as weather permits.

## Applicants Sought for Snohomish Public Safety Commission

Applicants are being sought to fill a vacancy on the City of Snohomish Public Safety Commission. The applications are due to the City Clerk by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, September 28, at City Hall, 116 Union Avenue in Snohomish.

The Public Safety Commission member term runs for four years. The Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police, reviewing written recommendations to the Liquor Control Board for new or renewal applications. The Commission reviews law enforcement priorities, the coordination of Neighborhood Watch and Snohomish Police Foundation, coordination of the Fire District's Community Emergency Response Team, and related matters.

The Commission's membership shall consist of residents of the City or owners of businesses located within the corporate City limits. All City board and commission members are volunteers serving without compensation.

The vacancy was created by the decision of Public Safety Commissioner Sue Sullivan to resign. The selected appointee will fill the balance of Ms. Sullivan's term which expires April 18, 2016. Ms. Sullivan has served as a Commission Member since April 2012.
