




SIGN AREA WORKSHEET

For more information, refer to SMC Chapter 14.245



Maximum wall-mounted sign area is 10% of the total square footage of the street-facing façade of the building plus an additional 25 square feet (see figure). The 25 square foot allowance applies to the entire building.

Sign area can also be determined through a Master Sign Plan developed by the building owner and approved by the City. If you are in a multi-tenant building, ask your landlord about a Master Sign Plan before designing your sign. It will provide important size and design information.

In the space below, measure the façade facing the street or main parking area only. Total allowable sign area is split among tenants in multi-tenant buildings.
