



**City of Snohomish
Private Stormwater Facility
Contractors Available for Detention Facility Maintenance**

Many developments within the City of Snohomish contain private stormwater detention facilities in the form of stormwater ponds or concrete vaults located on private property or within the homeowner’s association common property.



Property owners within each respective development containing these private stormwater facilities are responsible for ensuring that these stormwater facilities are properly maintained and functioning as designed per Snohomish Municipal Code Chapter 15.16.

Proper maintenance and functionality requires regularly inspecting these stormwater facilities and performing maintenance when necessary. Appropriate maintenance activities may include invasive species management, sediment removal, fence repair, etc.



In some cases maintenance may require the use of a contractor that can provide special equipment or expertise. When hiring a contractor, it is recommended to obtain at least three competitive bids, making sure to provide each contractor with the same information and list of requested services.

The City of Snohomish has compiled a list of local contractors in the table below that perform these maintenance services. The City
