

# Poll Results from Midtown Task Force Meeting #3

October 13, 2020

**Poll 1: Should the maximum building height in the southern overlay be kept at 35' or increased to 45'?**

35': 5 votes (41.7%)

45': 7 votes (58.3%)

**Poll 2: Should taller heights be applied uniformly in the northern overlay area or should they only be allowed on larger lots?**

Uniformly: 5 votes (41.7%)

Taller only on larger lots: 5 votes (41.7%)

Didn't vote: 2 (16.6%)\*

**If buildings are allowed to be higher than the suggested base maximum of 45', how high should buildings be allowed in the North Overlay area?**

55': 7 votes (58.3%)

75': 3 votes (25%)

Didn't vote: 2 (16.6%)\*

\* Two Task Force members didn't vote as an indication of their preference that maximum building height should be kept at 35' and not even be allowed to go to the assumed minimum of 45'.
