

GET THE LEAD OUT

Do you know what type of water line you have??

The best place to locate your water line is in the crawl space or basement, where the line enters through the foundation. The line may also be visible going into the hot water tank.

Once you've visually located the pipe, we've included some pictures to assist you.



If the pipe appears corroded, it can be challenging to identify immediately. If you're uncertain, use a scraping tool and gently scrape a small section of the pipe:

1. Lead Pipe: If the scraped area appears shiny and silver, your service line is made of lead.
2. Copper Pipe: If the scraped area is copper color, similar to a penny, your service line is copper.
3. Galvanized Steel Pipe: If the scraped area remains a dull gray, and magnet sticks to the surface, your service line is composed of galvanized steel.
