**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SNOHOMISH ADOPTING THE
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE YEARS
2024 TO 2029 TO BE FILED WITH THE STATE SECRETARY OF
TRANSPORTATION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.77.010, the City is required to annually review its Transportation Improvement Program and update it for the ensuing six years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council reviewed the Transportation Improvement Program from the previous years and has considered the current City transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said proposed Transportation Improvement Program was held on the 18th day of July, 2023, before the City Council of the City of Snohomish;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SNOHOMISH, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**

That the Transportation Improvement Program for the years 2024 to 2029, as set forth in Attachments "A" and "B" is found to be in the best interest of the City of Snohomish and consistent with the estimated revenues available for arterial construction together with such additional sums as the City may request from other sources, and the priorities as shown in Attachments "A" and "B" are hereby adopted.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to immediately file the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program adopted herein with the Secretary of Transportation for the State of Washington.





CITY OF SNOHOMISH Project Locations: Six Year Transportation Improvement Plan


Each project is numbered with a Transportation Improvement Plan (T.I.P.) priority number.

6 YEAR TIP: 2024–2029 Priority List

Priority #	Project Name	Year	Description/Scope & Status
1	Pavement Preservation Program	2024	Six Year Street Resurfacing {Transportation Benefit District (TBD) Funds – varies per year)
2	Sidewalk Repair Program	2024	Annual repair of approximately 600 LF of Curb, Gutter & Sidewalk (\$60k annual budget)
3	Bickford Avenue & 19 th Place	2025	Design & Construct Intersection Improvements (No work to date – TBD Funds)
4	Pine Avenue & Second Street Traffic Signal Improvements	2025	Design & Construct a roundabout (No work to date – not budgeted)
5	Bickford Avenue & Weaver Road Traffic Signal Improvements	2025	Construct a New Traffic Signal. Design 90% complete. Federal Grant construction funds of \$394,480 to be available early 2024.
6	Second Street & Avenue J Intersection Improvements	2026	Channelization on Second Street & Avenue J to eliminate NB turning movements from First Street. Also, converting small most western section of First Street to a one-way eastbound (No work to date – not budgeted)
7	Interurban Trail Improvements	2027	Design & Construction - Improvements to both improve the Interurban Trail and to help facilitate a crossing of Maple Avenue for trail users & link the Centennial Trail to the Interurban Trail (No work to date – not budgeted)
8	Maple Avenue & 10 th Street Intersection Improvements	2028	Design & Construct a Mini Roundabout (No work to date – not budgeted).
9	Maple Avenue & Pine Avenue Intersection Improvements	2028	ROW Acquisition, Realignment, New Curb, Gutter & Sidewalk, ADA & Stormwater Improvements (No work to date – not budgeted).
10	Second Street & Avenue D Intersection Improvements	2028	Safety issue due to number of driveway access points in vicinity. Project will upgrade traffic signal and implement access management strategies (No work to date – not budgeted).
11	20 th Street Extension – Bickford Avenue to Lake Avenue	2029	New Alignment/Roadway Extension Improvements with Connection Signal @ SR9 (WSDOT) (No work to date – not budgeted).
12	Signal Improvements	2029	Update Controllers, Conflict Monitors, and City-wide Signal Synchronization (No work to date – not budgeted).
13	Bickford Avenue Transportation Improvements	2029	Median Landscaping, Channelization Improvements, ADA Improvements with New Curb, Gutter & Sidewalk, Stormwater LID Improvements (No work to date – not budgeted).
14	First Street Pedestrian Safety & Enhancements Implementation	2029+	Replace Street Lights, ADA Improvements, Bulb-out Demonstration, Landscaping & Sidewalk Repair (No work to date – not budgeted).
15	Sinclair Avenue & Bickford Avenue Intersection Improvements	2029+	Design & Construct a New Traffic Signal & realign southwest leg of intersection (No work to date – not budgeted).
16	Second Street Corridor Improvements	2029+	Design 90% Complete funded by Pedestrian & Bicycle Grant. Construction – Add bulbouts, channelization improvements, and signal coordination along Second Street between Avenue J and Lincoln Avenue. Significant utility work/projects for the entire corridor must precede the Second Street Corridor Improvement project (Construction not budgeted).
17	Seventh Street & Avenue D Intersection Improvements	2029+	Safety issue due to number of driveway access points in vicinity. Project will upgrade traffic signal and implement access management strategies (No work to date – not budgeted).
18	Avenue A Corridor Improvements	2029+	Upgrade corridor to existing City roadway standards along Avenue A Between Second Street and 13th Street (No work to date – not budgeted).
19	22 nd Street Connector	2029+	Design & Construct - Street corridor from Terrace Ave to Pine Ave in City unopened right of way. Full road section with pedestrian and bike facilities. (No work to date – not budgeted).
